



## Caravan / Motorhome Top Cover (12-14ft)

### Fitting & Care Instructions

#### IMPORTANT:

- Do NOT attempt to fit the cover in windy conditions
- Do NOT use your Caravan's heating system with the cover fitted
- Do NOT attempt to drive the vehicle with the cover fitted
- Do NOT over-tension the straps as this may damage your cover
- We advise to NOT use this cover in high wind or exposed locations

#### BEFORE FITTING YOUR COVER:

- Remove, fold away or cover any sharp or fragile objects (such as aerials, guttering, wing mirrors, awnings and ladders etc) on the exterior of your caravan to avoid damage to both them and the cover
- Close all windows and rooflights etc
- Ensure that fridges and heaters etc are turned off and the handbrake is applied
- Ensure the exterior of the vehicle is dry before fitting the cover and it **MUST** be clean and free of debris/loose particles/grit in order to prevent any scratching or damage to the paintwork

#### FITTING YOUR COVER:

TWO people and the careful use of stepladders or a stable platform will be required as the cover is large, heavy and needs to be passed carefully over all sections of the caravan. **WARNING:** If using stepladders or platform you will be working at height and should follow carefully the manufacturers safety guidance for this. You should not attempt to fit the cover from the ladder but only use the ladder if required to assist people on the ground.

1. Open the cover out, pass over the roof starting from the front and working towards the rear, being careful to lift over any roof lights etc. **NOTE – the cover can be adjusted and moved using the straps (the front of the cover is labelled).** Adjust the covers position until an even fit is achieved.
2. The integrated straps can then be secured to the vehicle (Avoid fitting to loose objects or the trim of the vehicle).
3. **NOTE – the straps should be positioned so that the hem of the cover is as flat as possible against the sides of the vehicle as this will reduce the chance of wind getting under the cover. Straps are more secure when looped around something with the hook and attached back onto the strap itself.**
4. Make sure the straps are well tensioned and secure.
5. Once the straps are secured, put the protective cover over the buckle to protect paintwork and tuck in any strap ends to stop them moving in wind etc.

**CARE OF YOUR COVER:**

- Allow the cover to dry completely before storing in the bag provided
- Always brush or shake off any dirt and debris before using the cover
- Do NOT machine wash or tumble dry the cover. Remove dirt with a soft sponge and warm water. Do NOT use detergent
- Do NOT expose this cover to sparks, flames or other sources of ignition
